SIZE

To fit foot circumference	20	23	26	cm

Foot length - as desired				

YARN

Fine Art

1 1 1 x 100gm
(photographed in Hare 001)

NEEDLES

Set of 5 double-pointed 2½mm (no 12/13) (US 1) needles
OR 2½mm (no 12/13) (US 1) circular needle, 80 cm long if using the magic loop technique

TENSION

32 sts and 42 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 2½mm (US 1) needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

M1L = make one stitch by picking up horizontal loop before next stitch from front and knitting into back of it; **M1R** = make one stitch by using left hand needle and picking up horizontal loop before next stitch from behind and knitting into front of it; **wyab** = with yarn at back (WS) of work; **wyaf** = with yarn at front (RS) of work.

SOCKS (both alike)

Using 2½mm (US 1) needles cast on 68 [76: 84] sts.

Taking care not to twist cast-on edge, now work in rounds as follows:

Round 1 (RS): (K1 tbl, P1) 3 [4: 5] times, P1, K3, P1, K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) 4 times, P1, K3, P2, K1 tbl, (P1, K1 tbl) 6 [8: 10] times, P2,

K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) 4 times, P2, (K1 tbl, P1) 4 [5: 6] times.

Place marker on needle to denote beg and end of rounds.

Round 2: (K1 tbl, P1) 3 [4: 5] times, P1, sl 1, K2, pss0, P1, K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) 4 times, P1, sl 1, K2, pss0, P2, K1 tbl, (P1, K1 tbl) 6 [8: 10] times, P2, K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) 4 times, P2, (K1 tbl, P1) 4 [5: 6] times.

Round 3: (K1 tbl, P1) 3 [4: 5] times, P1, K1, yfwd, K1, P1, K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) 4 times, P1, K1, yfwd, K1, P2, K1 tbl, (P1, K1 tbl) 6 [8: 10] times, P2, K1 tbl, (P2, K1 tbl) 4 times, P2, (K1 tbl, P1) 4 [5: 6] times.

Round 4: As round 1.

Rep last 4 rounds 4 times more.

Place charts

Round 1: K5 [7: 9], P2, work next 21 sts as row 1 of chart A, P2, K12 [16: 20], work next 19 sts as row 1 of chart B, K7 [9: 11].

Round 2: K5 [7: 9], P2, work next 29 sts as row 2 of chart A, P2, K12 [16: 20], work next 27 sts as row 2 of chart B, K7 [9: 11].

Last 2 rounds set the sts - Patt from chart A with 2 sts in rev st st at each side and patt from chart B, both with st st between.

Cont as set, working the 18 round and 4 round patt reps from chart A **throughout** BUT working chart rows 1 to 21 of chart B **once only** then working the 19 sts of chart B in st st, until work meas 15 cm, dec 1 st at end of last round. 67 [75: 83] sts.

Heel flap

Turn work so that **WS** is now facing and now working backwards and forwards in **rows**, not rounds, cont as follows:

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1, P31 [35: 39].

Now working on these 32 [36: 40] sts **only** cont as follows:

Row 2: *Sl 1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows 14 times more, then row 1 once again, ending with RS facing for next row.

Turn heel

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1 wyab, K18 [20: 22], sl 1, K1, pss0, K1, turn.

Row 2: Sl 1 wyaf, P7, P2tog, P1, turn.

Row 3: Sl 1 wyab, K to 1 st before gap, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, turn.

Row 4: Sl 1 wyaf, P to 1 st before gap, P2tog, P1, turn.

Rep rows 3 and 4 until all the heel sts have been worked and 20 [22: 24] sts rem for heel.

Shape gusset

Now beg working in rounds again as folls:

Next round (RS): Sl 1, K19 [21: 23], pick up and knit 16 sts down row-end edge of heel, patt across 35 [39: 43] sts of upper foot, pick up and knit 16 sts up other row-end edge of heel, then K first 36 [38: 40] sts again and reposition marker, placing marker after last stitch worked to denote new beg and end of rounds. 87 [93: 99] sts.

Round 1 (RS): Patt 35 [39: 43], sl 1, K1, pssso, K to 2 sts before end of round, K2tog.

Round 2: Patt 35 [39: 43], K to end.

Rep last 2 rounds 9 [8: 7] times more. 67 [75: 83] sts.

Last round sets the sts – first 35 [39: 43] sts worked in patt, with rem sts worked in st st.

Foot

Cont as set until foot meas approx 5 [5.5: 6] cm less than desired foot length, ending after patt round 6, 12 or 18.

Next round: K8 [10: 12], K2tog, (K17, K2tog) twice, K to end. 64 [72: 80] sts.

Shape toe

Round 1 (RS): (K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K26 [30: 34], K2tog, K1) twice. (4 sts decreased).

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: (K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K24 [28: 32], K2tog, K1) twice.

Last 2 rounds set the toe shaping.

Cont as set, working 2 sts less between each set of decreases until 20 [24: 28] sts rem.

Cut yarn, leaving a tail approx. 30 cm long.

Following instructions on information page, graft sts together to close toe.
